Departure point

- Departs: daily, all year round
 - Departure Point: Ayers Rock Resort
 - Departure Time: 95 minutes prior to sunrise
 - Arrives back approximately 5 hours after sunrise
- Complementary transfer from/to selected hotels included before departure time
- Departure & Return times vary throughout the year due to different sunrise times. Precise timings will be provided with booking confirmation.

How to get there

Complementary transfer from/to selected hotels included. Please indicate the name of your hotel at the point of booking - the most convenient pick-up location and time will be advised in your booking confirmation.

Reconfirmation requirements

Please be advised you are required to contact The Service Provider 24 hours prior to the travel date during business hours to reconfirm your booking, pick up location and time, and departure time with your confirmation number. Please adjust your travel plan according to the details given by The Service Provider at time of reconfirming.

Check-in requirements

Please arrive 10 minutes prior to the pick-up time at your booked pick up location. There might be 5-10 minutes delay depends on the traffic on the day. If you think the pick is late or you are not being picked up, please call The Service Provider and quote your confirmation number to double check.

What to bring/wear

- Appropriate clothing for all weather conditions, eg. jacket for cooler months.
- Comfortable enclosed walking shoes
- Protective clothing, hat, sunscreen lotion, and sunglasses
- Water bottle to hold 2 litre, Snacks
- Flynet in summer months (optional)
- Money/credit card for optional purchases

Enjoy the intimacy of a small group to view sunrise at Kata Tjuta (the Olgas) and a walk with your Guide to the Valley of the Winds. Hear fascinating stories of the geology, history and culture of Kata Tjuta. This incredible formation of rock domes extends 6 kilometres into the ground and is the remains of erosion that began more than 500 million years ago. The walk to Valley of the Winds takes you down into a timeless haven within the domes through trickling creek beds.

Kata Tjuta (The Olgas)

A 45 minute drive west of Uluru (Ayers Rock) is Kata Tjuta (the Olgas), a must see geological marvel and one of the two main features in Uluru - Kata Tjuta National Park.

Unlike the single stone mass that makes up Uluru, Kata Tjuta is made up of 36 imposing domed rock formations, aptly named 'many heads' in the local Anangu language. The alternative name, the Olgas, comes from the tallest peak Mt. Olga which was named after Queen Olga of Württemberg in 1872. This tallest peak stands at a towering 1066 metres above sea level.

For those with a good level of fitness the Valley of the Winds is a longer walk that takes you through several domes and delivers breathtaking views. Whichever trail you choose, you'll be amazed by the plants and animals that have survived the harsh Australian desert and be rewarded with a view of the outback like you've never seen before.

Highlights

- Departing the resort you'll be one of the first to enter Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park today
- Travel to the Kata Tjuta Dune Viewing platform and enjoy a warming tea, coffee or hot chocolate with your light breakfast
- Watch the dawn creep across the desert plain and light up the domes of Kata Tjuta
- Join your Driver Guide and Guide for the walk to the first lookout, Karu - your Guide will point out interesting rare plants along the way
- If you're feeling adventurous, take the challenging walk with your Guide to the second lookout, Karingana, and enjoy the spectacular views into the heart of this sacred men's area
- For something more sedate, join your Driver Guide for the walk through Walpa Gorge, following the path between two of the towering domes of Kata Tjuta
