How to get there

By Car -

Werribee Open Range Zoo is located 35 kilometres west of Melbourne's city centre, on the Princes Freeway. It is a short 30-minute drive from the city over the Westgate Bridge or via the Geelong Road. (Take the Werribee South exit to K Road.)

By Public Transport -

From Melbourne, step 1, catch a train from the Melbourne CBD to Werribee station (travelling on the Werribee Line). Step 2 from Werribee station catch Bus 439 Werribee South to the Zoo.

Check-in requirements

Concession ticket type- valid concession ID must be presented on entry, including Australian Pensioner Concession Card, full-time Australian student card, Healthcare Card, Disability Concession Card, or DVA Gold Card.

What to bring/wear

- Appropriate clothing for all weather conditions, eg. jacket for cooler months.
- Comfortable enclosed walking shoes
- Protective clothing, hat, sunscreen lotion, and sunglasses
- Water bottle, Snacks
- Umbrella / raincoat if rains
- Money/credit card for optional purchases

Other info

- Children under 16 receive FREE entry on weekends, Victorian Public Holidays and Victorian Government School Holidays
- Concession ticket type- valid concession ID must be presented on entry, including Australian Pensioner Concession Card, full-time Australian student card, Healthcare Card, Disability Concession Card, or DVA Gold Card.
- With restrictions easing across the state, fitted face masks are now only required for those aged eight and above if you attend the Crazy About Cats keeper talk at Werribee Open Range Zoo. This is to keep animals safe as they can catch COVID-19 too!
