【Skyrail - Smithfield Terminal (Address: 6 Skyrail Dr, Smithfield QLD 4878)】

• By Car

Located approximately 14km north of Cairns, takes about 20 minutes; approximately 15km south of Palm Cove, takes about 20 minutes; approximately 55km south of Port Douglas, takes about 50 minutes.

• By Public Transport

Unfortunately there is no direct public transport available. Most visitors drive or arrive on a coach tour. If you do not drive, please book "Railway Start".

Check-in requirements

Please ensure you arrive at the meeting point /departure point 30 minutes before your scheduled departure time to allow enough time to check in. Regrettably, failure to arrive before this time will most likely be classified as no-show and result in forfeiting the booking and it cannot be refunded or transferred.

If you are not familiar with the area or travelling on a weekend or local public holidays / school holidays, please make sure you've checked your timetable or driving route beforehand, and allow extra travelling time for unexpected delays to ensure you do not miss your check in

【Important Post-Covid Service Information】

- Guests aged 16 years and older must be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 from 17 December 2021. Upon entry all guests must provide proof of Covid-19 vaccination or medical exemption documentation. Guests aged 16 years and older, unable to provide the vaccination or medical exemption documentation will be refused entry and no refund will be offered as the consequence.

- In off peak periods, exclusive gondola use may be offered.

- Skyrail and Scenic Railway package availability is limited & sold out on certain days. Round trip (return) Skyrail experiences are recommended.

● Days of Travel

Travel on Skyrail and Kuranda Scenic Railway must be completed on the same day. Kuranda Scenic Railway cannot be split for travel on separate days.

● Operating hours may change due to maintenance, improvements or safety reasons. Please always check with the Service Provider visit their official website for updated information regarding scheduled maintenance and closures before purchasing, and when closer to travel date to plan your visit.

● Freshwater Railway Station (Kuranda Scenic Railway) is approximately 7km from Skyrail

Smithfield Terminal, please make your own way back to your vehicle at the completion of the journey.

[Skyrail Rainforest Cableway]

- Children (14 years and younger) must be accompanied by an adult throughout the duration of the Skyrail experience.
- Each standard gondola seats a maximum of 6 people (including infants) or a maximum of 480kg (1058 lbs) whichever is first. Non-shared use of gondolas is subject to availability.
- Please note that timings are dependent on cableway operational constraints and may be longer than these recommended times.
- You can spend as much time as you like at Skyrail's rainforest mid-stations enjoying the facilities and rainforest atmosphere.
- For the protection of the environment, smoking and the consumption of food and drink is prohibited in all gondolas. Eating and drinking is allowed at all of Skyrail's Terminals and Stations.
- Day packs and fold up strollers can be taken on Skyrail Rainforest Cableway. Luggage is not permitted on the cableway or bus transfers. Small coin operated lockers are available at Smithfield (Cairns) Terminal (subject to availability and at own risk).
- Skyrail endeavours to limit any delay or disruption in service. However, where the service is delayed or disrupted for safety reasons or due to circumstances outside Skyrail's control (for example, due to inclement weather) Skyrail will not be liable for any loss, damage or inconvenience arising from or incidental to any such delay or disruption.

[Skyrail Rainforest Cableway]

Skyrail Rainforest Cableway takes you on an amazing experience over Australia's World Heritage listed Tropical Rainforest canopy and deep into the forest. A one way Skyrail experience should take approximately 1½ hours, this includes spending time at the two rainforest stations Red Peak and Barron Falls.

[Kuranda Scenic Railway]

Board the historic Kuranda Scenic Railway as it meanders its way between Cairns and Kuranda. Opened in 1891, this famous railway ascends from the coastal plains of Cairns through Freshwater Railway Station and on to Kuranda, the Village in the Rainforest, some 328 metres (1,076 feet) above sea level. Your historic journey in fully refurbished vintage carriages includes English commentary and a short photo opportunity stop at Barron Falls.

Skyrail Rainforest Cableway

Skyrail Rainforest Cableway is an iconic, must-do experience that takes guests over and through the World Heritage listed Wet Tropics Rainforest, home to the oldest continually surviving tropical rainforest on Earth. Immerse yourself in the sights, sounds, smells and tranquility of one of the world's most botanically fascinating areas that has remained relatively unchanged for 130 million years. The cableway stretches 7.5 kilometres or 4.7 miles between Smithfield (Cairns) and Kuranda. There are 32 towers in total and the highest tower stands 40.5 metres (133 feet) high.

Enjoy a truly unique perspective of this ancient landscape with unsurpassed panoramic views of Barron Gorge and Australia's Wet Tropics World Heritage Area. Glide metres above the pristine jungle canopy between Smithfield (Cairns) and Kuranda, enroute descend to explore the rainforest close up at Red Peak and Barron Falls. Red Peak is Skyrail's highest point at 545 metres above sea level (1,788 feet). The Kuranda Terminal sits at 336 metres (1,100 feet) and Smithfield (Cairns) Terminal is just 5 metres above sea level (16 feet).

Traversing the ancient rainforest between Smithfield and Kuranda, a one-way Skyrail Experience will take approximately 90 minutes to complete including time spent exploring Red Peak and Barron Falls.

- **Smithfield (Cairns) Terminal**

Skyrail Rainforest Cableway is located just 15 minutes north of Cairns city and 50 minutes south of Port Douglas. Traverse the spectacular landscape between Smithfield (Cairns) and Kuranda, on your 90 minute experience. A glimpse into an ancient world nestled in the fascinating Barron Gorge.

- **Discover Red Peak – it's a jungle down there!**

Descend through the canopy to explore one of the most ancient pockets of rainforest on Earth, where unique plants and animals have survived the forces of nature and time. This is the home of lush fern gardens, climbing palms, rare butterflies, birds and imposing rainforest giants, all of which are in constant competition for life-giving light. Exploring the rainforest at Red Peak is an experience not to be missed, so allow yourself approximately 20 minutes to encounter, discover and immerse yourself in this fascinating living museum.

- **Discover Barron Falls – a prehistoric landscape**

Known as Din Din to the Djabuganydji people – Barron Falls is a sacred place that has been an important part of their storytelling for thousands of years. While it is a spectacular sight at any time of the year, it really comes into its own during the wet season (December to March), when tropical rains bring the waterfall to life. Exploring the spectacular, rugged beauty and pioneering history is an experience not to be missed. Plan to spend around 20 minutes discovering the rainforest stories of Barron Falls.

Trip Timings

Stations: Smithfield Terminal - Red Peak Station - Barron Falls Station - Kuranda Terminal

- **Smithfield Terminal - Red Peak Station**

- Gondola Travelling Time: approximately 10 minutes
- Distance: 2.7 kms
- At Red Peak Station: Rainforest boardwalk including complimentary Ranger Guided Tour. Plan to spend approximately 20-30 minutes

- **Red Peak Station - Barron Falls Station**

- Gondola Travelling Time: approximately 12-14 minutes
- Distance: 3.1 kms
- At Barron Falls Station: Rainforest Interpretation Centre, lookouts, historical display. Plan to spend approximately 20-30 minutes.

- **Barron Falls Station - Kuranda Terminal**

- Gondola Travelling Time: approximately 7-8 minutes
- Distance: 1.7 kms

If commencing journey from Kuranda Terminal, the stops will be in reverse.

Planning Your Trip

- You can start with either Skyrail Rainforest Cableway or Kuranda Scenic Railway
- A one-way **Skyrail Cableway** journey takes approximately 1 ½ hours including time spent exploring Red Peak and Barron Falls.
- First Skyrail experience departure is at 09:30 from Smithfield and the last experience departure is at 15:15 from Kuranda.
- Skyrail Gondolas depart continuously throughout the day and bookings are made in 15 minute intervals.
- A one-way **Kuranda Scenic Railway** journey takes approximately 1 ½ hours.
- Morning trains depart from Freshwater Railway Station to Kuranda at 08:55 and 09:55.
- Afternoon trains depart from Kuranda to Freshwater Railway Station (continuing to Cairns Central Railway Station) at 14:00 and 15:30.
- Morning departures are from Freshwater Railway Station only and are not available from Cairns Central Railway Station.
