How to get there

By Car -
From Hobart, you'll need to drive 45 minutes south to the Bruny Island Ferry Terminal in Kettering. We suggest arriving at the ferry terminal 30 minutes prior to the ferry departure. The ferry is charged by per vehicle. Passengers in all vehicles and pedestrians travel free of charge. The ferry crossing takes 20 minutes and once you're on Bruny Island, Adventure Bay is a 40 minute drive south.

Check-in requirements

Please arrive at the ticket office 30 minutes prior to the departure time to exchange for ticket/boarding pass before proceeding to the boarding terminal

What to bring/wear

- Motion-sickness medicine (if required)
- Protective clothing, hat, sunscreen lotion, and sunglasses
- Comfortable shoes
- Appropriate clothing for all weather conditions, eg. jacket for cooler months. Make sure you dress warmly for the cruise - warm jackets, scarves, beanies and gloves are recommended.
- Camera
- Money/credit card for optional purchases

- Food is not included in the tour. Alternatively, you can upgrade your day to Bruny Island Full Day Tour from Hobart which includes morning tea and lunch
- To catch the ferry from Kettering
 - 10:00 Cruise: please catch 07:30 or 08:30 ferry from Kettering
 - 11:00 Cruise: please catch 08:30, 09:00, 09:30 ferry from Kettering
 - 13:30 Cruise: please catch 11:30 or 12:00 ferry from Kettering
- Please confirm with your hire car company whether there are any restrictions to travel on Ferry/Barge. Alternatively, you can always join our Kettering Bus Pick Up Service.

Enter deep sea caves, pass through the narrow gap between the coast and 'The Monument' and feel the power of nature at the point where the Tasman Sea meets the might of the Southern Ocean.

Join in the search for the abundant coastal wildlife such as seals, dolphins, migrating whales and sea birds. The highly trained interpretive guides love what they do - they work hard to ensure that the experience is fun, enjoyable, entertaining and informative.

The custom-built yellow boats are ideal for viewing the spectacular coastline and wildlife of Bruny Island. Each vessel holds a maximum of 43 guests. Covered open-air tiered seating means an excellent all-round view and connection with the environment. The boats are safe, comfortable and gentle on the environment due to their fuel efficiency, low emission and quiet operation.

Incredible Encounters with Wildlife

Keep a close lookout for sea eagles soaring above the cliffs, pods of dolphins surfing the bow wave, albatross wheeling on the wind and shearwaters skimming the swells. At the Friars, guests will drift quietly past rare nesting seabirds and a large haul-out home to thousands of seals.
