After that, across the Daintree River to get to Cape Tribulation just in time for lunch. Then, stop at the Alexandra Lookout and take in panoramic views of the ocean and the lush rainforest. Finally, end the tour with the Daintree River Cruise, and get a chance to see more native animals including crocodiles, snakes, and more!

Marvel at stunning Rainforest views at Alexandra Range Lookout and search for wild crocodiles on a Daintree River Cruise. Includes morning tea and a tropical lunch.

07:00	Commence pickups from Cairns accommodation.
07:45	Depart Cairns. Travel to Port Douglas via the Captain Cook Highway, one of Australia's most scenic coastal drives.
08:05	Commence pickups from Port Douglas accommodation.
08:45	Arrive at <b>Wildlife Habitat</b> . See the endangered cassowary and other wildlife.
10:00	Depart Wildlife Habitat.
11:00	Cross the Daintree River on the <b>cable-driven ferry</b> . Travel along the rainforest-fringed Cape Tribulation Road through Daintree National Park, a magnificent wilderness region.
12:15	Arrive at Cape Tribulation Beach House for a <b>Tropical Lunch</b> , followed by free time for a walk along the spectacular <b>Cape Tribulation Beach</b> .
13:15	Depart Cape Tribulation Beach House and visit Cape Tribulation Beach and Boardwalk for a guided rainforest walk with great photo opportunities.
14:35	Depart Cape Tribulation for return journey, with some comfort stops along the way.
15:35	Stop at <b>Alexandra Lookout</b> for magnificent views.
16:00	Depart north side of river for the <b>Daintree River Cruise</b> . Search for crocodiles, birds and other wildlife as journey through the mangroves.
18:00	Arrive at Port Douglas accommodation.
19:00	Arrive at Cairns accommodation.
