## How to get there

### • By Foot

Perched on Riverside Quay in the Southbank precinct by Melbourne's Yarra River, Eureka Tower is an easy walk from the CBD, Flinders St Station, Federation Square and Crown Casino.

### • By Car

Closest Parking:

- Wilson Parking - Eureka (Address: 70 City Rd, Southbank VIC 3006), approximately 1 minutes walk
- Parking fees apply

Wilson Eureka Parking is located right beneath the Eureka Tower on the corner of City Road and Southgate Avenue (enter via Southgate Avenue). Park at Wilson Eureka Parking and enjoy a discounted flat rate.

• Wilson Eureka Parking is owned and operated by Wilson Parking, prices are subject to change without notice.

### • By Public Transport

Located in the heart of Melbourne, public transport options are plentiful. From Flinders Street Train Station, simply walk five-minutes

over the bridge to the other side of the Yarra River. Multiple trams also service the Southbank area, particularly along St Kilda Rd, a short walk away from Eureka.

The closest Train Station is Flinders Street Station  
The closest Tram Stop is Casino East/Queens Bridge St  
The closest Bus Stop is 80 City Rd Stop

### Melbourne Skydeck (Eureka Skydeck 88) Entry Ticket

Every great city has its icon, its point of recognition, the gem in its urban skyline. For Melbourne, it's the Eureka Tower, a 297 metre (975 ft.) gold plated skyscraper by the Yarra River in the heart of the Southbank precinct. High up on the 88th floor, 285 metres above sea level, here is Melbourne's greatest point of view, and one of the most stunning observation decks in the world.

Nothing you have ever experienced will prepare you for the awe inspiring views from the highest viewing platform in the Southern Hemisphere at Melbourne Skydeck.

Melbourne Skydeck is Melbourne's must see attraction. Two dedicated lifts propel visitors to level 88 in under 40 seconds. Only Melbourne Skydeck can take you to The Edge, a switchable glass cube which slides out from the building, with you inside. (Edge Experience is at own cost)

Apart from the unforgettable panorama, Melbourne Skydeck entertains the entire family with a host of activities and fascinating facts. Located in Southbank, Melbourne Skydeck will change the way you look at Melbourne and beyond.

## FACTS

- Melbourne Skydeck is the highest public vantage point in the Southern Hemisphere
- The top of the Tower can flex up to 600mm in high winds
- There are two 300,000-litre water tanks on level 90 & 91 prevent any excess swaying
- 3,680 stairs - 92 storeys - 52,000 sq. metres of windows
- The glass on Eureka's top 10 levels is 24 carat gold plated
- Eureka used 110,000 tonnes of concrete and weighs 200,000 tonnes.
