- Departure Point: Pier 3, Barrack Street Jetty, Perth
- Departure Time: 07:45 (approx.)
Departure time is reference only and subject to availability.
Transfer from/to selected hotels included before departure time.
- Arrives back at approximately 17:45

How to get there

- By Car
You can find a limited number of paid parking bays at Barrack Street Jetty which are available for up to two or three hours at a time. If you need more time at Barrack Street Jetty you can find longer parking options just a short distance away.
- Parking fees apply
- By Public Transport
The Elizabeth Quay Train Station & bus terminal is a 9 minute walk from Barrack Street Jetty.
Please check the Transport Perth timetables (<https://www.transperth.wa.gov.au/>) for more details to plan your trip.
- Free Hotel pick-up/drop-off Service
Complimentary from/to selected hotels included before departure time. Please indicate your choice at the point of booking - the most convenient pick-up location and time will be advised in your booking confirmation.

Check-in requirements

- By Car/Public Transport
Please ensure you arrive at the meeting point /departure point 30 minutes before your scheduled departure time to allow enough time to check in. Regrettably, failure to arrive before this time will most likely be classified as no-show and result in forfeiting the booking and it cannot be refunded or transferred.

If you are not familiar with the area or travelling on a weekend or local public holidays / school holidays, please make sure you've checked your timetable or driving route beforehand, and allow extra travelling time for unexpected delays to ensure you do not miss your check in

- Hotel pick-up Service
Please arrive 10 minutes prior to the pick-up time at your booked pick up location. There might be 5-10 minutes delay depends on the traffic on the day. If you think the pick is late or you are not being

picked up, please call The Service Provider and quote your confirmation number to double check.

What to bring/wear

- Motion-sickness medicine (if required)
- Appropriate clothing for all weather conditions, eg. jacket for cooler months.
- Comfortable enclosed walking shoes
- Protective clothing, hat, sunscreen lotion, and sunglasses
- Water bottle, Snacks
- Umbrella / raincoat if rains
- Insect repellent
- Camera
- Money / credit card for optional purchases

Other info

- Bicycles must be collected on the island by an Adult (18+). Bicycles must be returned to Pedal and Flipper by 17:00.

- Child Policy

- Children under 4 years of age travel free of charge provided they do not occupy a seat.

- In the interest of safety, children aged twelve or under are not permitted to travel without direct supervision from a parent or adult guardian.

- Rottnest Island Government Admission Fees

All visitors to Rottnest Island are required to pay a Government Admission Fee, or 'landing fee' which is collected from island visitors by the ferry companies on behalf of the Rottnest Island Authority. This fee contributes to the conservation of the Island, provisions and upkeep of facilities. This fee will be included in the total price of your ferry fare, and is payable at the time of booking.

- Taking Pets to Rottnest Island

- Rottnest Island has an especially unique environment and is a Class A Reserve.

- Pets are NOT allowed on the Island under any circumstances.

- Registered Guide Dogs: If there is a genuine medical requirement to bring an animal with you such as a guide, assistance or companion dog this is acceptable, however please contact the Rangers prior to arrival on (08) 9372 9788.

Bike Hire - discover Rottnest Island by bicycle!

Cycling is environmentally friendly and a fun recreational activity for all ages. As Rottnest Island has no private vehicles, cycling is also one of the best modes of transport on the Island. To ride around the entire island (22kms) you would need between 3-5 hours, alternatively there are shorter routes available.

SKIP THE LINE! Make your way from the ferry to the Pedal and Flipper shop behind Hotel Rottnest. You can line up at the priority queue making it quick and easy to get your bike. Your bike hire will include a helmet and lock. The Bike Hire team is trained to personally fit customers to bikes to ensure optimum comfort and safety.
