How to get there

• By Car

Located approximately 40km north of Margaret River, takes about 35 minutes; approximately 33km west of Busselton Visitor Centre, takes about 35 minutes; approximately 255km south of Perth, takes about 2 hour 55 minutes.

Check-in requirements

Please ensure you arrive at the meeting point /departure point 10 minutes before your scheduled departure time to allow enough time to check in. Ngilgi Cave is an exquisitely decorated cave; and it was Western Australia's first tourist attraction. It is home to incredible stalactites, stalagmites, helictites and beautifully coloured shawls.

Ngilgi Cave is located near Yallingup, at the northern end of the Cape to Cape region. European discovery occurred in 1899, with the cave formerly being known as Yallingup Cave.

The Semi-Guided Show Cave Tour is approximately one-hour duration and begins with an introductory talk from the cave guide while being led down into the first chamber or 'The Amphitheatre'. Visitors can then explore at their own pace, while another guide stationed in the centre of the cave can answer questions and provide more information on the many beautiful areas within the cave.
