How to get there

Complimentary transfer from/to Ayers Rock Airport included. Please indicate the name of your hotel and flight details at the point of booking - the most convenient pick-up location and time will be advised in your booking confirmation.

Reconfirmation requirements

Please be advised you are required to contact The Service Provider 24 hours prior to the travel date during business hours to reconfirm your booking, pick up location and time, and departure time with your confirmation number. Please adjust your travel plan according to the details given by The Service Provider at time of reconfirming.

Check-in requirements

Please arrive 10 minutes prior to the pick-up time at your booked pick up location. There might be 5-10 minutes delay depends on the traffic on the day. If you think the pick is late or you are not being picked up, please call The Service Provider and quote your confirmation number to double check.

What to bring/wear

- Small overnight bag with personal towel & toiletries. No toothbrush, toothpaste, or slippers provided
- Appropriate clothing for all weather conditions, eg. jacket for cooler months.
- Comfortable enclosed walking shoes
- Protective clothing, hat, sunscreen lotion, and sunglasses
- Water bottle to hold 1.5 litre, Snacks for Day 2 breakfast
- Umbrella / raincoat if rains
- Insect repellent
- Flynet in summer months (optional)

- Children under 18 years old must be accompanied by a person 18 years and over.
 - People travelling with children please consider whether the itinerary is suitable, in particular the activities involved and the duration of the tour, to ensure the comfort of small children. For all tour types children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
 - It is against the law to sell or supply liquor to anyone under the age of 18 years old in Australia. Customers who are under 18 will only be served with soft drinks. It is strongly recommend that travelers who are 18 years old and over please bring a valid photo ID (a valid passport, drivers licence, or proof of age card) which can prove your age when dining / travelling.
- Fitness Requirements
 - Uluru: Low level of fitness required. Approximately 1 hour gentle walk
 - Kata Tjuta: Moderate level of fitness required. Uneven surfaces to complete Walpa Gorge walk.
 - Guests can return to the coach at any time if needed
- Flight Information
 - Day 1: Please book your flight to arrive prior to 13:30 into Ayers Rock Airport
 - Day 2: Please book your flight to depart after 12:45 (Oct-Mar) and 13:30 (Apr-Sep) from Ayers Rock airport
- Accommodation
 - The Couple rate will be applied 2 adults sharing a Double or Twin room.
 - The Trio rate will be applied to 3 adults sharing a Triple room.
 - The Child rate applies to children sharing a Triple room.
 - Triple Rooms: The configuration of a triple room may include a foldaway, sofa bed or rollaway as the third bed.
- Luggage Allowance
 - One medium size suitcase that is not exceeding 76cm x 46cm x 25cm (30" x 18" x 10") per person plus one piece of hand luggage which may be carried on-board the coach. Please note that luggage with an adjustable handle and wheels will not fit in the overhead compartments and cannot be accepted as hand luggage.
 - Maximum weight of the suitcase not to exceed 23kg (50lbs). The Service Provider is required by strict Government vehicle weight regulations to enforce and adhere to this limit. If your luggage exceeds this limit, please make alternative arrangements for the excess to be forwarded to the termination point of your tour.
 - All luggage and personal effects are at all times and in all circumstances at the risk of the tour participant. Luggage insurance is strongly recommended.

Day 1 Uluru (Ayers Rock)

Welcome to Ayers Rock! You will be transferred from Ayers Rock Airport to your hotel (Please book your flight to arrive prior to 13:30).

This afternoon, visit the Uluru- Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre. Later travel around the base of Uluru with a local Driver Guide. Learn about the native flora, fauna and intriguing cultural traditions of traditional owners, the Anangu, and discover an array of fascinating sacred sites. Join your Driver Guide for a walk to Mutitjulu Waterhole. You'll explore a number of caves and view Aboriginal rock paintings as your Guide interprets their meaning and significance. Travel to the Uluru sunset viewing area, 'Sunset Strip' and relax with a glass of wine and Nibbles as the sun sets over the western horizon and the evening sky brings out the many shades of colour for which Uluru is renowned.

Please Note: If you are arriving via a Red Centre Connection or Flight, you may not have time to check into your hotel room before your afternoon tour departure time. Please have a Day Pack ready to go which includes the following items - Appropriate walking shoes, hat, sunscreen, warm jacket during the cooler months & a minimum of 1 litre of water.

Please ensure you have a minimum of 1 litre of water with you for your walk.

Hotel: Desert Gardens Hotel

Desert Gardens Hotel is centrally located to all resort and touring facilities and offers a range of accommodation, from shaded poolside rooms to deluxe rooms overlooking the desert.

Day 2 Uluru (Ayers Rock) & Kata Tjuta (Olgas)

Rise early to watch the first rays of the sun set Uluru and the Red Centre alight. Make your way to the viewing platform to see many kilometres into the distance, providing an ideal photo opportunity. After sunrise travel to the mystical domes of Kata Tjuta. On the way enjoy panoramic views of the southern side of Kata Tjuta before arriving at Walpa Gorge to take a walk that follows the natural creek-bed between two of the main domes. In the afternoon you will be transferred to Ayers Rock Airport for your flight.

You will be transferred from your hotel to Ayers Rock Airport. Please book your flight to depart after 12:45 (Oct-Mar) or 13:15 (Apr-Sep) if you are leaving Ayers Rock after this tour.

Please reconfirm the pick-up time with your Hotel Concierge 24 Hours prior.
