What to bring/wear

refunded or transferred.

- Motion-sickness medicine (if required)
- Appropriate clothing for all weather conditions, eg. jacket for cooler months.
- Comfortable enclosed walking shoes
- Protective clothing, hat, sunscreen lotion, and sunglasses
- Water bottle, Snacks
- Swimmers and towels
- Umbrella / raincoat if rains
- Insect repellent
- Camera (waterproof if swimming)
- Money / credit card for optional purchases

Other info

- Itinerary may be subject to change due to weather conditions in the wet season.
- All dietary requirements must be notified at the time of reservation, or at least 72 hours notice before travel. The Service Provider caters for vegetarians and most other requirements within reason and providing they are of a medical nature.
- Tour not suitable for wheelchairs. Due to the remoteness, the ruggedness of the area, steps and uneven ground on the National Park Boardwalks and into Emmagen Creek, passengers must be able to take walking steps by themselves or with the aid of their own carer. Wheelchairs must be small compact collapsible chairs as space is limited. This must be checked at the time of reservation and confirmed at least 72 hours prior to the tour. The Service Provider's Staff are unable to assist with any lifting or assistance due to insurance liability and not being the authorised carer.

Group size is limited for a more personalised experience. As one of the only tour operators to travel on the Bloomfield Track your experience will be like no other. Spot crocodiles on a Daintree River cruise, learn about flora, fauna and the history of the Daintree on a guided boardwalk tour, take a 4WD ride through a World Heritage-listed rainforest on the rugged Bloomfield Track, savour a traditional Aussie barbecue, sample traditional 'Aussie' billy tea, damper and tropical fruits in the company of wallabies and enjoy a homemade Daintree ice-cream on your journey home.

Sample Itinerary

Itineraries are subject to change, modification and some destinations may not be reached at the discretion of the Service Provider's guide on the day due to weather or road conditions, possible road closures, COVID-19 related closures and the safety of all passengers.

- Your naturalist guide will meet you at your accommodation and after introductions all round you'll then drive north along the scenic route via Mossman to Cape Tribulation.
- **STOP 1 - Daintree Rainforest River Cruise & Morning Tea**
Lush farmland contrasts with seascape as you approach the majestic Daintree River. Time for a short morning tea break then its 'all aboard' for an informative river cruise. Relax and enjoy the splendour only the Daintree can offer as you learn of Estuarine Crocodiles, mangrove forests and wildlife, this is nature at its best!
- **STOP 2 - Alexandra Lookout**
You'll ascend the Alexandra Range and pause for a panoramic view of World Heritage Tropical Rainforest merging with the azure colours of the Coral Sea.
- **STOP 3 - Guided Boardwalk Tour (easy grade)**
Experience the rainforest intimately on the elevated National Park Boardwalk. Accurate interpretations of flora and fauna will be given with ample time for photographs and questions as you search for the elusive, rare and totally unique Southern Cassowary and other wildlife species within this habitat.
- **STOP 4 - Lunch**
Enjoy lunch at a local cafe in the Daintree Rainforest region. (dietary requirements catered for with prior notice)
- **STOP 5 - Emmagen Creek Wildlife Spotting & Swim**
This tour does a little more, it takes you beyond Cape Tribulation along 7klms of the 4WD Bloomfield Track too pristine Emmagen Creek and time for a refreshing rainforest freshwater swim. Seek fish and turtles in the creek, butterflies and exotic birds in the trees and indulge in a taste testing of tropical fruit which enhance the tranquil surroundings.
- **STOP 6 - Cape Tribulation Beach**
At Cape Tribulation Beach, there is a little time to stroll along the beach and boardwalk to the photographers' platform overlooking the mountains and coast where the 'Rainforest meets the Reef'. (There is no swimming at Cape Tribulation Beach due to dangerous Hazards)
- **STOP 7 - Daintree Icecreamery**
After a short afternoon refreshment stop for an ice-cream (at own cost), you'll cross the Daintree River by cable ferry and begin your homeward journey somewhat wiser for your 'Total Rainforest Experience'.
