Opera House Tour runs daily.
Tour & Dine closed on 11 September 2022, Good Friday, Christmas Day 25 December, New Year's Eve 31 December, New Year's Day 01 January and Australia Day 26 January.

Tour time:

- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Sunday: 11:30, 12:00, 13:00, 13:30, 14:00, 15:00

- Wednesday & Saturday: 11:30, 15:30

Tour & Dine includes:

1. 1 hour guided walking tour
2. English-speaking guide
3. Immersive digital experience: 5 minutes included in the 1 hour tour
4. Alfresco dining at House Canteen (or Opera Bar) between 11:30 and 18:00 on the day of the tour booking (1 main meal with 5 options plus 1 alcoholic/non-alcoholic drink per person)
5. Dining time can be chosen upon checking in for the tour at the Welcome Centre Stage Door, which can be a lunch or early dinner following the tour.

Check-in requirements

Please ensure you arrive at Welcome Centre 15 minutes before your scheduled departure time to allow enough time to check in. Regrettably, failure to arrive before this time will most likely be classified as no-show and result in forfeiting the booking and it cannot be refunded or transferred.

If you are not familiar with the area or travelling on a weekend or local public holidays / school holidays, please make sure you've checked your timetable or driving route beforehand, and allow extra travelling time for unexpected delays to ensure you do not miss your check in

- Wear comfortable shoes, as this is a walking tour with 300+ steps.

- Mobile phones are permitted on the tour however please ensure they are switched off or on silent for the duration of the tour.
